

Princeton Math Tournament Sponsorship Prospectus

Overview

The 2026 Princeton Math Tournament (PMT) is an inaugural student-organized math competition for upper primary and middle schoolers (grades 3 - 8). We expect to gather 300-500 students from schools across New Jersey and even New York and Pennsylvania to celebrate and spread their interest in math. The tournament features classic Mathcounts-style rounds (Sprint, Target, Countdown) along with unique additions including a high schoolers AMA, a puzzle round, and more. We are prospectively planning to hold the tournament at Princeton High School on February 21, and although the website is still under construction, it can be found at <https://tournament.phsmt.org/>.

About Us

We are a team of PHS Math Team members with extensive experience in leading youth math activities and organizing academic events, from the recent high school hackathon HackPHS to the annual Integirls NJ math competition. We build this high-quality math competition off of the problem solving experience of our team, including MPfG and USA(J)MO qualifiers, and collaboration from competing and placing in many national competitions including PUMaC, HMMT, and Purple Comet.
